1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the controversy involved in the present writ petition is squarely covered by the judgment dated 20.01.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 14638/2019, Chandra Kanta v. State of Rajasthan & Anr.** and the batch of connected writ petitions. He submits that the

Coordinate Bench, while allowing the said writ petitions, held that transfer orders whereby the petitioners were transferred from their respective Panchayat Samitis without specifying the place of their posting/joining could not be sustained.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents prays for short time to complete his instructions.

3. List the matter on 05.08.2026 along with SBCWP Nos.14556/2026, 14704/2026 & 16377/2026 after reflecting the name of Mr. Kuldeep Vaishnav, Dy.G.C. as counsel appearing for the respondents in the cause list.

4. In the meanwhile, the effect and operation of the impugned order dated 10.07.2026 (Annex.1) shall remain stayed qua the petitioner, in case, he has not joined at the new place of posting.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents would be at liberty to file application under Article 226 (3) of the Constitution of India.
