The petitioner has challenged the order dated 30.07.2022 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Bhinmal, District Jalore in Criminal Revision Case No.7/2021 whereby, the learned Judge dismissed the revision petition and affirmed the order dated 17.12.2020 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhinmal, District Jalore in Criminal Case No.853/2015 whereby, learned trial Court rejected the petitioner's application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. for summoning her father-in-law, mother-in-law and sisters-in-law as additional accused in this case.

Mr. Jasroop Chand Prajapat, father of the petitioner is present in person.

Vide order dated 18.12.2025, the Secretary, Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority, Jodhpur was directed to provide due assistance to the petitioner and her father through legal aid, but father of the petitioner has refused to accept the legal aid and submits that he himself will argue the case.

From perusal of the record, it appears that the aforesaid accused persons i.e. father-in-law, mother-in-law and sisters-in-law, against whom application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. for summoning them as additional accused was filed by the petitioner, have not been impleaded as party respondents in this petition, therefore, petitioner is directed to implead them as party respondents in this petition.

Let necessary exercise be carried out within a period of two weeks.
