1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the recommendation made by the Settlement Committee as constituted in pursuance to the order dated 08.08.2022 passed by the Additional District Collector, Hanumangarh, to regularize the *abadi* land in favour of the petitioner (of which he is in possession since years), although notice dated 14.02.2023 had been issued by the Chief Executive Officer to the petitioner to appear but however, no decision whatsoever, has been taken till date.

2. Counsel submits that now the respondent Gram Panchayat is bent upon to issue a *patta* of the land in question in favour of some other person without deciding the case of the petitioner.

3. In view of the submission made, Issue notice.

Issue notice of the stay application also.

Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due. Notices be made returnable on 11.11.2024.

Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.

4. Meanwhile, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner qua the land of which he is in possession of, excluding the land of public way. The Gram Panchayat shall be at liberty to take appropriate action for removal of the possession of the petitioner, if any, from the land of public way.
