Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner on the impleadment application, we permit him to implead Granesh Raj Bansal and Indra Kumar Hisariya as respondents No.5 & 6, who are alleged to be encroachers of the public land.

The impleadment application No.1/2022 is allowed. The amended cause title is accordingly taken on record.

The argument is that under the master-plan certain land was earmarked for the purpose of parks and playground but the aforesaid land is illegally occupied for the purpose of construction of shops in connivance with the municipal authorities. This fact is reflected from Annex.6 on page 25 of the writ petition.

Issue notice to the respondents.

Notices of respondents No.1 to 3 may be served in the office of learned Advocate General, who will ensure filing of the response by the aforesaid respondents within a period of one month.

Respondent No.4, Chairman, Nagar Parishad and respondents No.5 & 6, who are the private respondents shall be served by registered post and they are required to file their respective counter affidavits within one month of the service of notice.

In the meantime, if any constructions are raised in the open area as alleged that will be subject to the decision of the writ petition and would be liable to be demolished if found to be illegal.
