1. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that contends that the petitioner has no active role to play in the alleged incident and the impugned FIR registered against the petitioner is false and fabricated. It is further submitted that the complainant has challenged the FIR registered against him by way of filing a misc. petition under Section 528 BNSS (Section 482 Cr.P.C.) being S.B. CRLMP No.4952/2025, whereby notices have been issued to the respondents vide order dated 12.08.2025 passed by this Court.
2. The matter requires consideration.
3. Issue notice of the misc. petition as well as the stay petition.
4. Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 and 2. Let the notice be issued to the respondent No.3, returnable four weeks.



5. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 15.09.2025 at 11:30 am, join the investigation, and submit his representation/documents, if any.
6. Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to procure the latest status report/factual report/case diary, reflecting the petitioner's cooperation in the investigation, by the next date of hearing.
7. In the meanwhile and till the next date of hearing, the petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.76/2025 registered at Police Station Bagor, District Bhilwara.
