1. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner who is working as Teacher in a private school and having custody of two minor daughters, is unable to attend the proceedings at Family Court, Chittorgarh where an application under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed by the respondent-husband.
2. In view of the submissions made, Issue notice to the respondent, returnable within four weeks.

Notices be filed in two sets within a period of one week. On the same being filed, one set be given '*dasti*' to learned counsel for the petitioner for service through registered post acknowledgment due.

Postal receipts of the '*dasti*' notices be filed within a period of one week from the date of receipt of '*dasti*' notices.
