1. In compliance of bailable warrant issued vide order dated 29.01.2026, respondent No.3 is present in person before the Court.
2. Let his attendance be marked.
3. Bailable warrant qua respondent No.3 stands discharged.

S.B. Writ Contempt Nos. 1255/2019, 1253/2019 & 1259/2019

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners Mr. Mahesh Thanvi submits that although the complete principal amount has been

paid by the State as well as the Institute, the interest amount on the said principal amount has not been paid.

2. Counsel for the State as well as the respondent Institute pray for and are granted last opportunity of three weeks to pay the due interest amount on the principal amount already paid.

3. List the matters on 25.03.2026.

4. If the reply/compliance report is not filed by the next date, the Director, Elementary Education shall remain present before the Court.

5. Respondent No.3 shall also remain present before the Court on the next date if the interest amount as payable by the Institute is not paid.

S.B. Writ Contempt Nos. 1254/2019, 1258/2019 & 1260/2019

1. An application for substitution of legal representatives of petitioner- Bikram Singh Yadav who is reported to have expired on 08.12.2020, has been filed in S.B. Writ Contempt No. 1258/2019.

2. For the reasons stated in the application, the same is **allowed**. The legal representatives of the deceased petitioner are permitted to be taken on record.

3. Amended cause title as filed be taken on record.

4. Office to make online amendments.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners Mr. D.D. Chitlangi submits that despite the order been passed by the Court in the year 2019, the amount qua the share payable by the Institute has not been paid to the petitioners till date. So far as the share qua the State

is concerned, he submits that although the same has been paid, the interest on the said amount has not been paid.

6. Counsel for the respondent State however submits that it is only the difference amount qua the selection grade which was paid in the month of December 2025. Other than that, the complete amount was paid in the year 2023 itself. Therefore, no interest is payable.

7. Counsel appearing for the Institute submits that last opportunity of one week be granted and the complete share of the Institute with interest, would be paid to the petitioners by the next date.

8. In view of the submissions made, list the matters on 25.03.2026.

9. Let a reply/ compliance report be filed by the respondent State as well as the respondent Institute by the next date.

10. If no reply/compliance report is filed by the next date, the Director, Elementary Education shall remain present before the Court.

11. Respondent No.3 shall also remain present before the Court on the next date if the amount as payable by the Institute is not paid.
