The present criminal misc. petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 BNSS for quashing of FIR No.071/2024 registered at Police Station Jaitsar, District Anupgarh for the offences under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the challan in the case was filed in the month of September 2025, however the petitioner being not at all involved in the case is being enroped on the ground that accused came to meet him, after the deal was done. The alleged fact is not denied by the learned Public Prosecutor.

This Court has failed to understand under what circumstances the petitioner is being enroped in the alleged offence. The investigation in the matter seems to be clearly unfair.

In view of the same, this Court is inclined to interfere in the matter.

Issue notice.

Learned Public Prosecutor accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Let notice be issued to respondent No.2, returnable within four weeks.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No.071/2024, registered at Police Station Jaitsar, District Anupgarh, however, he shall join the investigation.

The Investigating Officer shall remain present before this Court on the next date of hearing so as to explain why he is involving the petitioner into the said offences.

List this case on 25.02.2026.
