1. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the impugned order passed by learned Single Judge of this Court is based upon the order passed in *S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.2784/2024*, (*Anirudh Sharma vs. RPSC & Anr.*).
2. Learned counsel for the appellant has shown the order passed by a Division Bench of this Court at Jaipur Bench in the case of ***Lokesh Meena vs. Anirudh Sharma (D.B. Special Appeal Writ No.523/2024)***, on 19.09.2024, which reads as follows:-

Mr. Sandeep Pathak, learned counsel enters appearance on behalf of respondent No.1 and takes notice.

Mr. Dilip Singh, learned counsel enters appearance and takes notice on behalf of respondent No.2-RPSC.

Mr. Vigyan Shah, learned Additional Advocate General enters appearance and takes notice on behalf of respondent No.3.

Accordingly, service is complete.

In the meanwhile, taking into consideration that without any equivalence having been drawn by the State/employer, the relief has been granted to private respondent based on an equivalence drawn by the Dean of the educational institution, effect and operation of the impugned order shall remain in abeyance.

Counsels for the respondents are granted two weeks' time to file reply to stay application/application for vacation of order."

3. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.

4. In the meanwhile, effect and operation of the order dated 30.07.2024 passed in S.B.C.W.P. No.11655/2024, shall remain stayed.
