The present interim bail application under Section 483 BNSS has been filed by the petitioner on the ground that petitioner's daughter underwent a leg operation which is now in recovery stage and the doctor has specifically advised her for regular physiotherapy. The petitioner's wife is also suffering from severe depression and so being sole care taker of family the petitioner's presence is essential to look after his daughter and wife. In such circumstances, it is prayed that the petitioner may be released on interim bail for a period of 30 days.

2. Learned Public Prosecutor, in compliance of order dated 25.09.2025 of this Court, has produced the factual report dated 05.11.2025 indicating the factum of the petitioner's daughter's medical condition.

3. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant interim bail to the accused petitioner for a period of 30 days.

4. Accordingly, the interim bail application filed under Section 483 of B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that petitioner Farukh S/o Bhavar Khan arrested in connection with F.I.R. No.125/2024, registered at Police Station Bhojasar, Phalodi for the offence under Section 8/22 of the NDPS Act, be released on interim bail for a period of 30 days, subject to the condition that he shall deposit a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (out of which one surety will be a close relative of the petitioner) each to the satisfaction of learned trial court for his surrender on completion of 30 days from the date of actual release.

5. Let this bail application be again listed on 02.01.2026 Learned Public Prosecutor shall be required to submit the compliance report of the order as to whether the petitioner has surrendered or not.
