By way of filing the present writ petition, the petitioner has
prayed for the following reliefs:-

*"a) It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that the
Provisional Attachment Order dated 12.09.2020 (Annexure-
1) in respect of Khasra No. 562 (mentioned in para 10.10 of
the Provisional Attachment Order) may kindly be quashed
and set aside, on the footing that prohibitory instructions in
respect of similarly situated and adjacent Khasra No.561
have been withdrawn.*

*b) That the order dated 26.03.2021 (Annexure-10), passed
under Sub-section (4) of Section 8 of PMLA, may kindly be
quashed and set aside."*

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No. 2, i.e., the Directorate of Enforcement, Government of India, New Delhi, fairly submitted that a detailed reply to the writ petition has been filed, wherein the said respondent has admitted that the process to remove the subject property, i.e., Khasra No. 562, from confiscation/seizure under PAO No. 05/2020 dated 12.03.2020, has been initiated.

3. In view of the aforesaid statement made at the Bar by the learned counsel for the respondent, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to all concerned authorities, including the learned Special Judge, CBI Cases No. 3, Jaipur Metropolitan-I (Special Court under the Prevention of Money Laundering Act, 2002), to pass necessary orders for releasing the property situated at Khasra No. 562 from attachment, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of one month from the date of this order.

4. Stay application also stand disposed of.
