1. The instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed in relation to a service matter.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.
3. After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the present writ petition at this stage and seeks liberty for the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation before the competent

authority of the respondent department, ventilating her grievance regarding non-consideration of her request for transfer to her home district.

4. In view of the submission so made, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed, with liberty as prayed for.

5. It is directed that in the event the petitioner submits a detailed representation before the competent authority within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided objectively, strictly in accordance with law and policy in this regard, by passing a reasoned and speaking order, within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of such representation. The decision so taken shall be communicated to the petitioner forthwith.

6. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case and all issues are left open to be considered by the competent authority.

7. In case the grievance of the petitioner still persists, she shall be at liberty to avail appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

8. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. All pending applications are disposed of.
