1. On the last occasion, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner who was working with the respondent-Municipal Council since the year 2016 as a Fireman, has been orally terminated and has not been permitted to continue.
2. In view of the submission made, learned counsel for the petitioner was directed to serve a copy of the writ petition on the counsel who represents the respondent-Department.
3. Today, learned counsel appearing for the respondent-Municipal Council submits that the petitioner was working through a placement agency and as the term of the placement agency has expired, the services of the petitioner *ipso-facto* stood terminated.

Counsel submits that the placement agency was awarded the tender in the year 2024 which expired in the year 2025.

4. He however, prays for time to file reply.

5. The submission as made by learned counsel for the respondents *prima facie* seems to be incorrect in view of the documents as placed on record which reflect the petitioner to be appointed and working with the Department before the year 2024.

6. List the matter on 17.10.2025.

7. Reply to the writ petition be filed by the next date.

8. Till the next date, the petitioner shall be permitted to continue on the post he was working.
