1. The present criminal misc. application has been filed by the petitioner against the order dated 19.05.2022 passed by this Court in S.B. Criminal Revision Petition No. 417/2022, whereby the respondent No. 2 was released on bail.

2. Bail once granted to the accused can be cancelled on the following grounds:

I. The accused is found to be tampering with or destroying evidence;

II. The accused is interfering with the prosecution witnesses or otherwise obstructing the fair trial;

III. The accused has committed any offence while on bail;

IV.The accused has jumped bail or has attempted to abscond/flee the country;

V. Subsequent facts have emerged after the grant of bail which show that the accused is likely to interfere with the investigation or the trial.

3. This Court finds that in the present application, the petitioner/complainant has failed to make out any of the aforesaid grounds. There is no allegation or material on record to show that the respondent has violated any of the conditions of bail or has misused the liberty granted to him.

4. Accordingly, the present criminal misc. application is dismissed.
