Order

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 12.11.2024 has granted interim protection to one Sawan Kumar Chayal (S.B. Criminal Misc(Pet.) No.7972/2024). Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the case of the present petitioners is not worse than the case of the Sawan Kumar Chayal who has already been granted interim protection and, therefore, the petitioners may also be granted interim protection.
2. Learned Public Prosecutor submits that the offences alleged against the petitioners have found to proved by the investigating agency, and therefore, the petitioners are not entitled for any interim protection by this Court. However, learned Public Prosecutor was not in a position to refute the fact that the co-

accused persons namely Sawan Kumar Chayal (S.B. Criminal Misc(Pet.) No.7972/2024), Jamna Lal Kumawat (S.B. Criminal Misc. Petition No.2986/2025) and Nitendra Pal Singh (S.B. Criminal Misc. Petition NO.2987/2025) have already been granted interim protection by this Court.

3. In that view of the matter, this Court deems it just and proper to direct the Investigating Officer not to arrest the petitioners till the next date of hearing in connection with FIR No.340/2024, registered at Police Station Ambamata, District Udaipur for the offences under Sections 409, 420, 406, 467, 468, 471, 379 and 120-B of IPC.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor is directed to keep the investigating officer along with C.O. diary/ case diary present before this Court on the next date of hearing.

5. List these matters on 21.05.2025 along with S.B. Criminal Misc(Pet.) Nos.7972/2024 (Sawan Kumar Chayal vs. State of Rajasthan & Anr.), 2986/2025 (Jamna Lal Kumawat v. State of Rajasthan & Anr.) and 2987/2025 (Nitendra Pal Singh v. State of Rajasthan & Anr.).

6. Interim order(s), if any, shall continue till the next date of hearing.
