1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in an identical petition being *S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.18947/2025; Shree Bhagwan Agarwal & Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.*, a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court has already passed an interim order on 24.09.2025 in the presence of counsel for the respondents.

2. Mr. S.R. Paliwal, learned GC submits that copy of the writ petition has been served on him today only.

3. In *Shree Bhagwan Agarwal* (supra), the Court passed the following interim order:

"1. Mr. Shyam Paliwal, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that it is a proven fact that houses have been constructed on the limited land available in the concerned Gram Panchayat and State Government has sent proposal for expansion of the Abadi area, in furtherance of the letter dated 22.08.2023, sent by the Secretary, Panchayati Raj Department. He further submitted that proposal for expansion of the Abadi area is pending consideration of the State Government and in the meantime, if the

respondent-authority takes any coercive action, not only petitioners' fundamental right to shelter shall be taken away but also their right of regularization of possession shall also be impaired.

2. Issue notice to the respondents.

3. Mr. Sanjay Raj Paliwal, G.C., learned counsel accepts notices on behalf of the respondents. Therefore service is complete.

4. Meanwhile, neither the petitioners shall be dispossessed from their possession nor shall their constructions be demolished.

5. Since, no response have been filed by the respondents so far, it will be open for them to move an application for vacation of interim order, while filing reply."

4. In view of the above, let reply be filed by the next date.
