The matter has come up for orders on an interlocutory application (No.01/2025) filed on behalf of the convict petitioner seeking extension of period of the emergent parole granted to him by this Court vide order dated 25.11.2025.

This Court, vide order dated 25.11.2025, granted emergent parole to the convict-petitioner for a period of twenty days from the date of his actual release, on the ground of ailment of the petitioner's wife.

Learned counsel submitted that the wife of the petitioner is in critical condition and her treatment will take time. Learned counsel thus prayed that the period of emergent parole may be extended for a further period of 20 days.

Considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner at Bar and the fact that some more time is required for treatment of the petitioner's wife, the application deserves acceptance.

The period of emergent parole granted to the petitioner vide order 25.11.2025 is extended upto **20.12.2025**. The petitioner is directed to surrender before the concerned jail authorities on or before **21.12.2025** on the same terms and conditions mentioned in the order dated 25.11.2025 passed by this Court. It is made clear that the emergent parole granted to the petitioner shall not be further extended.

The application (01/2025) stands allowed in above terms.
