1. Instant bail application has been filed by petitioner under Section 483 of BNSS in connection with FIR No. 24/2025 registered at Police Station- Pratapgarh, District- Pratapgarh for offence under Section 8/21 of NDPS Act.
2. Heard counsel for petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Having considered the fact that the recovered contraband (1.970 Kg. brown sugar crude) has been found to be a raw material to prepare the opium in the FSL Report and the same is less than commercial quantity; in the previous criminal antecedent, petitioner is stated to be acquitted; in the present case, petitioner is in custody since 19.01.2025; co-accused Mubarik @ Khaju has already been enlarged on bail by this Court vide order dated 04.12.2025 in SB Criminal Misc. Bail Application

No.7397/2025 and conclusion of trial will take considerable time, but without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to release the petitioner on bail.

4. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Anwar @ Dadhi S/o Fakir Mohammad Ajmeri** shall be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.

5. However, it is hereby directed that the petitioner shall not repeat the similar nature of offence and shall cooperate with the investigation, during bail granted by this Court, and in case, breach of any of the condition is reported or comes to the notice of the Court, same shall be the reason for the trial Court to cancel the bail, granted by this Court.
