1. There appears reasonable ground to go deep into the matter just to trace the elements of offence for which charges have been framed against the petitioner.
2. Issue notice.
3. Learned PP accepts notice, thus notice need not be issued.
4. Let a copy be supplied to him.
5. List the matter after one week.
6. Learned PP is required to convince this Court that how the petitioner was having control and possession of the vehicle or how it can be presumed that he was having knowledge that his vehicle would be used in contravention of penal provision of NDPS Act. At the same time, he would also require to convince that whether he abated the commission of offence or he conspired with the principal accused for the reason of which charges under Section 29 of NDPS Act has been framed.
