The instant application for bail under Section 483 of BNSS (439 of Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in the present matter. The requisite details of the matter are tabulated herein below:

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further submitted that petitioner has not been named in the FIR and he has no

active role to play in this incident. It is contended that the allegations against the petitioner is of providing shelter to the shooter before the said incident. It is further submitted that co-accused Tag Singh, Kamlesh Kumar and Vikas @ Vikki have already been enlarged on bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court vide orders dated 24.04.2024, 10.05.2024 and 27.08.2024 passed in S.B. Criminal Misc. Bail Application No.2903/2024, 5437/2024 and 9260/2024 respectively and the case of the present petitioner is on same footing as the case of the aforesaid co-accused. It is further submitted that charge-sheet has already been filed, petitioner is in judicial custody since 28.09.2025 and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time to conclude, therefore, the benefit of bail may be granted to the accused-petitioner.

Per contra, learned Public Prosecutor and Mr. Vineet Jain, learned Senior Advocate assisted by Mr. Harshwardhan Singh, learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the bail application but they have not refuted the fact that the aforesaid co-accused Tag Singh, Kamlesh Kumar and Vikas @ Vikki have already been enlarged on bail.

Having heard and considered the rival submissions, facts and circumstances of the case as well as perused the material available on record, considering that the co-accused Tag Singh, Kamlesh Kumar and Vikas @ Vikki have already been enlarged on bail, petitioner is in judicial custody since 28.09.2025 and the trial of the case will take sufficiently long time to conclude, without

expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 of BNSS (439 of Cr.P.C.) is allowed. It is ordered that the accused-petitioner as named in the cause title, arrested in connection with the above mentioned FIR, shall be released on bail, if not wanted in any other case, provided he furnishes a personal bond of Rs.50,000/- and two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each, to the satisfaction of learned trial court, for his appearance before that court on each & every date of hearing and whenever called upon to do so till completion of the trial.
