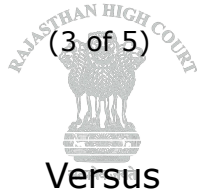

Order

1. The present matter pertains to those institutions which are conducting Nursing courses on account of interim protection granted by the learned Single Bench. These institutions are now facing issues arising from the order passed by the Division Bench of this Hon'ble Court whereby the respondents have restrained from allotting any seats for Nursing courses for the academic year 2025-26 without a valid No Objection Certificate (NOC).

2. Upon such application having been filed, this Court, on 27.10.2025, directed the learned Additional Advocate General to file an affidavit clarifying the status of the institution including the details regarding the courses being conducted as well as the status of current NOC of the institutions. Thereafter, on

30.10.2025, learned Additional Advocate General took some time, assuring the Court that NOC pertaining to the petitioner-institutions shall be duly considered and appropriate orders shall be passed within a period of ten days strictly in accordance with law.

3. The urgency in the matter arises from the fact that the counselling process was over, but as per the newspaper report, there are 3,000 seats still remain vacant and there is likelihood of them being permitted to be filled by the colleges, which are having a valid NOC. Learned Additional Advocate General has now seeks twenty days' time for finalizing to decide the NOC to the petitioner-institutions.

4. Upon such limited submissions having been made, list all these applications on 10.12.2025.

5. The respondents-State is directed to complete the process of deciding the issue of NOC pertaining to the petitioner-institutions particularly in cases, where the courses are being conducted by virtue of the orders of this Court or otherwise. The acceptance/rejection order will be passed on or before 10.12.2025 strictly in accordance with law.

6. Looking into the gravity of the matter, seriousness of the issue and repeated non-compliance on the part of the respondents, it is further directed that if the fate of the NOC of these institutions is not decided by that date, the Principal Secretary, Medical and Health Department, Government of Rajasthan, Secretariat, Jaipur shall personally remain present before this Court to explain the delay and the reasons why the order has not been complied with since long time.

7. In case university deems it appropriate to proceed with any subsequent round of counselling or filling up the seats, it shall be required to seek permission from this Court.
