Instant bail application has been filed by petitioners under Section 483 of BNSS in connection with FIR No. 200/2025 registered at Police Station- Gotan, District- Nagaur for offences under Sections 112, 121(1), 132, 109(1), 309(6), 318(4), 338, 336(3) and 340(2) of BNS, 2023, Section 3/25(6) of the Arms Act and Section 3 of the PDPP Act.
2. Heard counsel for petitioners as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Having considered the facts that petitioners have been implicated for an allegation to run away by breaking barricade and opening firearms on the Police Personnel, however, no injuries

caused to any human being; petitioners are in custody since 21.08.2025; there are single criminal antecedents of petitioners, and same are not for similar nature of offences; after investigation, charge-sheet has been filed and conclusion of trial will take considerable time, but without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to release the petitioners on bail.

4. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioners (i) **Girdari Ram S/o Bhanwaru Ram Alias Bhanwarlal** and (ii) **Chhotu Ram S/o Budharam** shall be released on bail provided each of them furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for their appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.

5. However, it is hereby directed that the petitioners shall not repeat similar nature of offence and shall not threaten the prosecution witnesses, during bail granted by this Court, and in case, breach of any of the condition is reported or comes to the notice of the Court, same shall be the reason for the trial Court to cancel the bail, granted by this Court.
