1. This instant application under Section 482 of BNSS is filed by the applicant-accused **Baggu Singh S/o Balwant Singh** for seeking anticipatory bail in event of arrest in connection with FIR No.244 dated 06.10.2025 registered at P.S. Hindumalkot, District- Sri Ganganagar, for alleged offence under Sections 196(1)(a) and 299 BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has falsely implicated in a concocted criminal case. He also submitted that the applicant may be arrested due to ulterior motive and to fulfill personal *vendetta* of complainant though there is no evidence against the applicant-accused. He further submitted that the applicant is a law abiding citizen having no previous criminal antecedents, but he assures full cooperation with Investigating Agency.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that on basis of a false report, the petitioner was arrayed as an accused. He also submitted that now investigation is complete. he also submitted that several persons of the vicinity have filed affidavit in support of petitioner. he also submitted that no where it has been proved that petitioner has committed any offence under Section 196(1)(a) and 299 BNS. He further referred the material and submitted that petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.
4. Aforesaid contentions were opposed by learned Public Prosecutor and submitted that the applicant-accused has committed an offence and his custodial interrogation is required hence, he is not entitled to anticipatory bail.
5. Heard learned counsel for the applicant-accused and learned Public Prosecutor. Perused the material available on record submitted by both the parties.
6. On basis of a complaint lodged by complainant Satnam Singh against Baggu Singh and Amandeep Singh on 06.10.2025 for incident between 01.09.2025 to 06.10.2025, the matter is investigated by police. Police has found involvement of present petitioner. We have considered the entire material on record.
7. Having considered the police report and the material placed on record for perusal, the matter is still at the investigation stage, but the investigation so far indicates that the petitioner-applicant is not required for custodial interrogation. Considering the assurance of cooperation and also the fact that there is no criminal antecedents against

the petitioner-applicant, without expressing any opinion on role of the present petitioner-applicant, it is appropriate to grant anticipatory bail.

8. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the bail application under Section 482 BNSS, is hereby allowed and it is ordered that in the event of arrest of applicant-accused **Baggu Singh S/o Balwant Singh** in connection with FIR No. 244 dated 06.10.2025 registered at P.S. Hindumalkot, District- Sri Ganganagar, for alleged offence under Sections 196(1)(a) and 299 BNS, the applicant **Baggu Singh S/o Balwant Singh** shall be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond of Rs. ₹50,000/- with two sureties of like amount to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer on the following conditions:-
- (i) Till completion of investigation, the applicant shall not leave the jurisdiction of the State of Rajasthan without prior permission of the concerned Court.
 - (ii) The applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by the Investigating Officer as and when required in relation to present criminal case.
 - (iii) The applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Investigating Officer during investigation.
 - (iv) The applicant shall not tamper with any evidence or try to influence any witness in any manner.

- (v) The applicant shall disclose his passport number, if any, to Investigating Officer and shall not leave the Country without prior permission from the concerned Court.
 - (vi) The applicant shall not indulge in any criminal activity and shall not repeat any criminal offence punishable under the Law.
 - (vii) Failure to comply with any of the aforementioned conditions, shall entail the cancellation of the anticipatory bail order.
9. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to the Trial Court through E-mail.
