1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner has a direct contract with the respondents, and the

respondents are changing the status of the contract. They intend to outsource the present petitioner through an outsourcing agency by the indirect contract method, a policy which has been deprecated by this Court vide order dated 20.03.2017 in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 953/2017** titled as **Pankaj Kumar Upadhyay v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.** This Court, vide order dated 20.03.2017, restrained the respondent authorities from altering the status of employees from direct contractual employees to employees engaged through an outsourcing agency.

2. In light of the aforesaid decision, this Court is inclined to grant an interim order restraining the respondent authorities from altering the status of the employees from direct contractual employees to indirect contractual employees, pending the present writ petition.

3. Admit.

4. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.

5. Post the matter on **15.12.2025.**
