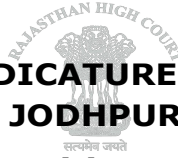

ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in light of the order dated 07.01.2025 passed by this Court in ***State Bank of India & Anr. v. Tulsi Devi & Ors. (D.B. Civil Writ Petition No.18546/2018)***, the present petitions do not survive.

2. In view of the aforesaid submission, and having regard to the order passed in *Tulsi Devi* (supra), this Court is of the considered opinion that the present petitions do not survive and the same are, accordingly, ***dismissed***. However, this Court takes note of the peculiar factual matrix, more particularly, the fact that the petitioners are widows, and that a deduction to the tune of Rs. 5,139/- is being made from their pensionary benefits. In the interest of justice, it is hereby directed that the monthly deduction installment be reduced from Rs. 5,139/- to Rs. 2,500/-, so as to mitigate the financial hardship being caused to the petitioners. Pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
