Learned counsel for the petitioner has preferred the present Criminal Miscellaneous Petition under Section 528 of the BNSS for quashing of the order dated 01.09.2025, to the extent of awarding maintenance of Rs. 75,000/- per month in favour of the respondent, passed by the learned Family Court No. 1, Udaipur in Case No. 134/2022. By the said order, the application for interim maintenance filed by the respondent under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C. was allowed, and the petitioner was directed to pay maintenance of Rs. 75,000/- per month to the respondent.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had resigned in January, 2025 and that rental income from the property situated in Jaipur is being received by the

respondent-wife. However, without pressing the petition on merits, he confines his prayer to a direction to the learned trial court to decide the matter expeditiously, while taking into consideration all relevant documents, which he shall place on record before the trial court.

Learned counsel for the respondent does not object to the limited prayer made by the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present criminal miscellaneous petition is dismissed as not pressed at this stage.

However, the learned trial court is directed to decide the main petition pending before it under Section 125 of the Cr.P.C. expeditiously, preferably within a period of four months.

The stay petition as well as all pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
