Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Bench at Jodhpur, vide the impugned order dated 17.02.2025, passed in Appeal Nos. 90/2023, 89/2023 and 87/2023, has directed the petitioners – Police Department to provide certain copies of documents sought by the respondents in an application dated 24.02.2022 filed under Section 76 of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872.

Learned counsel further submitted that the order passed by the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Bench at Jodhpur is wholly without jurisdiction, inasmuch as the respondent Jagdish Vishnoi cannot be termed as consumer of the petitioner department, and the request for supply of documents does not constitute a consumer transaction or deficiency in service.

The matter requires consideration.

Admit.

Issue notice to respondent No.1 only.

In the meanwhile and till further orders, the effect and operation of the order dated 17.02.2025 (Annexure-1) passed by the State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Bench at
