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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE FARJAND ALI**

**Order**

**17/11/2025**

1. None present for the respondent despite caveat.
2. A bare perusal of Annexure – 2, the recruitment form, making it abundantly clear that there was a specific query whether the aspirant was an ex-prisoner for which the response was "No". since the petitioner was not a prisoner at that time and this issue has been dealt with by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in S.B. Writ Petition No.12239/2025 **(Kajol Salvi Vs. state of Rajasthan & Ors.)**, decided on 07.07.2025. After her selection

and two days of her joining, she obtained a police verification certificate which was provided her duly having mentioning of pendency of a criminal case and as such as per her, there was no concealment of any material fact. Vide the impugned order dated 04.11.2025 (Annexure-14), her appointment has been cancelled.

3. After hearing the counsel for the petitioner and going through the totality of facts and circumstances of the case, particularly, the particulars mentioned in the application form, the police verification report and the other material annexed with the writ petition, this Court feels that interference of this Court would be required. Thus, issue notice. Issue notice of the stay application as well. Rule be made returnable within a period of four weeks.

4. In the meantime, the effect and operation of the order dated 04.11.2025 (Annexure-14) issued by the Deputy Director, Department of Ayush, Government of Rajasthan shall remain stayed and the petitioner shall be allowed to continue to work at her office.
