1. The instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed in relation to a service matter, wherein the petitioner has challenged the transfer order dated 22.09.2025 and relieving order dated 24.09.2025, and seeks continuation on the present post of Principal at Shaheed Deputy Commandant Vijaypal Singh Government Senior Secondary School, Gagawas, District Churu, inter alia on the ground that the impugned transfer has been effected arbitrarily and with the intent to accommodate respondent No.4.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not wish to press the present writ petition at this stage and seeks liberty for the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation before the competent authority of the respondent department.

4. In view of the submission so made, the present writ petition is dismissed as not pressed, with liberty as prayed for.

5. It is directed that in the event the petitioner submits a detailed representation before the competent authority within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be considered and decided objectively, strictly in accordance with law, by passing a reasoned and speaking order, within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of such representation. The decision so taken shall be communicated to the petitioner forthwith.

6. The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. All pending applications are also disposed of.
