1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the controversy raised in the present writ petition is identical to the controversy which was earlier raised before this Court in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.21160/2025 (***American International Health Management Ltd & Anr. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.***). In the said writ petition this Court issued notice on 30.10.2025 while granting interim relief.

2. The earlier writ petition filed by the petitioner institutes therein pertained to the MBBS UG course whereas the present writ petition pertains to PG MD/MS course. However, the controversy is identical in both the writ petitions.
3. Considering the submissions made above, issue notice of the writ petition to the respondents as well as of the stay application.
4. Learned counsel Mr. N.S. Rajpurohit, AAG appearing on Caveat accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents.
5. Service is thus, complete.
6. In the meantime and till the next date of hearing, fees structure (Annex.2) as published in the Instruction Booklet for State Medical PG seats (M.D./M.S) /Post MBBS DNB / Post MBBS Diploma Allotments 2025 qua petitioners shall remain stayed. However, it is made clear that any admission given on account of this interim order also the fee charged from students shall remain subject to the final outcome of the present writ petition.
7. Learned counsel Mr. N.S. Rajpurohit, AAG seeks time to file reply.
8. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents would be at liberty to seek vacation of interim order after filing reply.
9. Time prayed for is allowed.
10. List this matter on 09.12.2025 alongwith S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.21160/2025.
