1. The instant bail application has been filed by the applicant under Section 483 BNSS. The applicant has been arrested in connection with **FIR No. 72/2025** registered at Police Station **Bhawanda, District Nagaur** for the offence(s) under Section **137(2), 64(1), 64(2)(M), 127(2) of BNS and 3/4 of POCSO Act.**

2. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that prosecutrix is a minor girl and petitioner has falsely been implicated by stating age of prosecutrix to be of 17 years; as per statements of victim, she admits that she administered sleeping pills to her parents and other family members at night, in order to elope with petitioner on his motorcycle and they travelled to a different village and stayed there for two days; after investigation charge-sheet has been filed, petitioner is in custody since 12.08.2025 and the trial may take long time to conclude. Thus,

learned counsel submitted that the applicant may be enlarged on bail.

3. Per contra, none appears for the complainant despite service and learned Public Prosecutor vehemently opposed the bail application.

4. Considering the arguments advanced by the counsel for the parties and looking to the overall facts and circumstances of the case and taking into consideration the statements of victim wherein she admits to administer sleeping pills to her parents and other family members at night, in order to elope with petitioner on his motorcycle and then both travelled to a different village and stayed there for two days; after investigation charge-sheet has been filed, petitioner is in custody since 12.08.2025, but without commenting on the merits and demerits of the case, this court deems it just and proper to enlarge the accused-applicant on bail.

5. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-applicant **Balji @ Balaram S/o Ratnaram** arrested in connection with aforesaid FIR shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned lower court for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
