Drawing attention of the Court towards the memo of recovery, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that memo of recovery is shown to have been prepared on 31.01.2025 at 02:15 pm. Whereas, the memo directing constable – Ranaram to call for independent *mautabi* witnesses was drafted on the same day/date at 02:25 pm. Learned counsel submitted that the memo of recovery also indicates that the notices under Section 50 NDPS was given to the petitioner at about 02:50 pm. It was submitted that from the perusal of the memo of recovery and other documents available on record, it is apparent that the memo of recovery was prepared before the rest of the documents thereby creating a shadow of doubt upon the entire seizure proceedings.

On these grounds, learned counsel submitted that the petitioner may be enlarged on bail.

In support of his arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner placed reliance on the orders dated 22.11.2023 and 19.02.2024 passed by the co-ordinate Bench of this Court in S.B.

Learned Public Prosecutor submitted that she may be granted sometime to complete her instructions.

In that view of the matter, learned Public Prosecutor is directed to keep the Investigating Officer alongwith C.O. diary present before this Court on the next date of hearing.
