1. The present interim bail application under Section 483 of BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) has been filed by the petitioner who has been arrested in the present matter. The requisite details of the matter are tabulated herein below:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's wife is suffering from ovarian cyst and is undergoing treatment for the same. He further submits that treating doctor has advised her to undergo surgery. In this regard, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record various medical

documents. It is, therefore, prayed that the petitioner may be released on interim bail.

3. Vide order dated 05.12.2025, learned Public Prosecutor was directed to procure medical status report of the petitioner's wife. In compliance with the order dated 05.12.2025, learned Public Prosecutor has produced a report dated 06.12.2025, which reflects that the petitioner's wife is undergoing treatment for ovarian cyst. It also reflects that petitioner is having 8 previous criminal cases. The report is taken on record.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has opposed prayer for interim bail; however, he has not disputed medical status of the petitioner's wife.

5. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case, particularly the fact that the petitioner's wife is undergoing treatment for ovarian cyst and advised surgery, without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to grant interim bail to the accused-petitioner for a period of 20 days.

6. Accordingly, present interim bail application filed under Section 483 of BNSS (439 Cr.P.C.) is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner as named in the cause title, arrested in connection with the above mentioned FIR, shall be released on interim bail for a period of **20 days** subject to the condition that he shall furnish a personal bond in a sum of **Rs.5,00,000/-** with two sound and solvent sureties in the sum of **Rs.1,00,000/- (out of which one surety will be of a Government Servant to**

ensure the surrender of petitioner) each to the satisfaction of learned trial court for his surrender on completion of **30 days** from the date of actual release.

7. Let this bail application be again listed on 07.01.2026. Learned Public Prosecutor shall be required to submit the compliance report of the order whether petitioner has surrendered or not.
