1. Instant bail application has been filed by petitioner under Section 483 BNSS in connection with FIR No. 296/2025 registered at Police Station Bilara, District Jodhpur Rural for offence(s) under Sections 308(2) and 64(2)(m) of BNS, 2023.
2. Heard counsel for petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Taking into consideration the overall facts and circumstances of the present case and the fact that prosecutrix is a major lady and lodged the report after her marriage with someone else, stating inter alia, that prior to her marriage, about one year ago, petitioner maintained sexual relations with her by administering an adulterated juice at his home, when she was in unconscious state of mind, and after marriage, petitioner is blackmailing her to

make viral her obscene photographs; in the statements of husband and father-in-law of victim, they have stated that petitioner is demanding refund of some money allegedly credited by him to prosecutrix; there are no previous criminal antecedents of petitioner; petitioner is in custody since 09.10.2025; after investigation, charge-sheet has been filed and conclusion of trial may take a considerable time, but without commenting on merits of the case, this Court deems it just and proper to release the petitioner on bail.

4. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Gautam S/o Mohan Lal**, shall be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing as and when called upon to do so.
