1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioner. The accused-petitioner has been arrested in connection with FIR No. 195/2025 registered at Police Station Mukta Prasad Nagar, District Bikaner for the offences under Sections 3/25(1-B)(A), 25(6) of the Arms Act and Sections 111(2)(a), 111(3), 111(4), 308(4), 60(a) & 62 of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that charge-sheet has already been filed, no witnesses has been examined yet. He also submits that the petitioner's incarceration period is more than six months. The accused-petitioner is in custody since 07.09.2025 and the trial/investigation of the case may take considerable time,

therefore, the bail application of the accused-petitioner may be allowed.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application and contends that petitioner is a habitual offender and from his conscious possession a country made pistol along with cartridges were recovered. The petitioner is operating a gang, therefore, considering the aforesaid facts, the bail application of the petitioner deserves dismissal.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the fact that the accused-petitioner is in custody since 07.09.2025 and apart from framing of the charges, the trial court has not proceeded with the trial, therefore, looking to the long incarceration of the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner **Rajesh Tard S/o Ramesh Alias Rameshwar Lal**, in connection with FIR No. 195/2025 registered at Police Station Mukta Prasad Nagar, District Bikaner, shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
