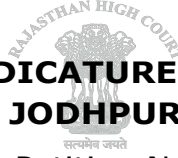

This writ petition has been filed by the petitioner challenging the order dated 22.09.2025 whereby the petitioner, who is presently working as Principal at Swami Vivekanand Model School (English Medium), Sagwara, District Dungarpur, has been transferred to Government Senior Secondary School (Hindi Medium), Neemdi, Bhinder, District Udaipur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the Government Notification dated 23.01.2023, particularly Clause/Point No. 13, an employee posted in an English Medium School cannot be reverted or transferred to a Hindi Medium School unless the employee himself applies for such reversion. It is



submitted that the petitioner has not submitted any such application and therefore the transfer order is contrary to the said policy.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner may be given liberty to move a representation before the competent authority for redressal of his grievances and the competent authority may be directed to decide the same by passing appropriate administrative order expeditiously in accordance with law.

4. Request seems to be fair.

5. In the aforesaid premise, the present writ petition stands disposed of. The petitioner is granted liberty to submit a representation before the competent authority within a period of two weeks from today. In the event such a representation is submitted within the stipulated period, the respondent-competent authority shall consider and decide the same by passing an appropriate administrative order in accordance with law.

6. Needful be done as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 06 weeks from today.

7. Accordingly, the writ petition as well as stay petition stands disposed of.
