1. Heard on the interim stay application.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners were previously engaged by respondent No. 7 to supply manpower to the MDM Hospital. Upon the selection of new outsourcing agencies (i.e. respondents No. 8 to 10), the services of the petitioners were disengaged.
3. He further stated that under a similar set of facts, employees of a similar kind working under respondent No. 7 were granted interim protection by directing the respondents to continue the services of the petitioners. This was to be done by sponsoring them through the new outsourcing agency instead of engaging fresh outsourced employees, even after a new outsourcing agency was selected. Such an order was passed in ***S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 21827/2025: Vinita Solanki & Ors. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.***, vide order dated 21.11.2025. The operative portion of the order dated 21.11.2025 (supra) reads as follows:

"12. In the above facts and circumstances, the respondents are directed to continue the services of the

petitioners who are duly working in the institutions through the respondent No.7 subject to their verification of actual working or not and if they are found to be working under the same post through respondent No.7 till new agency selected they shall be continued even under the newly selected agencies, until further orders.

13. They shall engage the petitioners, if already disengaged, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of this order."

4. In view of the aforesaid order, there shall be an interim directions as directed in the aforesaid order.
5. Issue notice to the respondents, returnable within a period of four weeks.
6. Post the matter on **06.02.2026**.
