The present Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, seeking quashing of FIR No. 194/2025 registered at Police Station Chohtan, District Barmer, for offences under Sections 115(2), 75(2), and 85 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that there exists a possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties. It is further submitted that the details of Respondent No. 2, including the contact number, shall be provided to the Mediation Centre

within a period of four days. Upon receipt of the same, the Registry shall issue notice to Respondent No. 2 and call upon him/her to appear in the mediation proceedings.

The matter is referred to the Mediation Centre attached to this Hon'ble Court.

The parties shall appear before the learned Mediator on 06.04.2026.

List the matter before this Court on 27.04.2026 along with the Mediator's report.

The Office is directed to communicate this order to the Mediation Centre forthwith.

In the meanwhile, and until the next date of hearing, the petitioners shall not be arrested in connection with FIR No. 194/2025 registered at Police Station Chohtan, District Barmer.
