1. The instant bail application has been filed under Section 483 BNSS on behalf of accused-petitioner. The accused-petitioner has been arrested in connection with FIR No. 589/2025 registered at Police Station Rawatsar, District Hanumangarh for the offences under Sections 332(b), 64 (2)(m) and 308(2) of BNS.
2. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner submits that the accused-petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the prosecutrix is a major lady and petitioner has been falsely implicated due to altercation took between the petitioner and the prosecutrix. He also submits that the prosecutrix in her Court statement has specifically stated that she did not report the matter on 18.09.2025 and lodged the FIR after 10 to 15 days. She has also stated that petitioner has made complaint against her with regard to telephonic conversation with other boys and altercation took place between them. It is also

contended that the FIR itself is delayed. The accused-petitioner is in custody since 09.10.2025 and the trial of the case may take considerable time, there are no criminal antecedents against the accused-petitioner, therefore, considering the above facts the bail application of the accused-petitioner may be allowed.

3. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

4. Heard and perused the material available on record.

5. Considering the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the petitioner, more particularly that prosecutrix is a major lady and the prosecutrix in her Court statement has specifically stated that she did not report the matter on 18.09.2025. The accused-petitioner is in custody since 09.10.2025 and the trial of the case may take considerable time, there are no criminal antecedents against the accused-petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, I deem it just and proper to enlarge the accused-petitioner on bail.

6. Accordingly, the bail application under Section 483 BNSS is allowed and it is ordered that the accused-petitioner Raju Alias Rajender S/o Rampratap, in connection with FIR No. 589/2025 registered at Police Station Rawatsar, District Hanumangarh, shall be enlarged on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Judge for his appearance before the court concerned on all the dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
