Considering the submission that, despite a detailed and reasoned resolution dated 27.06.2025 (Annex.5), recording a clear finding that no charges are made out, the subsequent notice dated 14.11.2025 (Annex.6) has been issued by the Commissioner (III), Department of Enquiry, Rajasthan, Jaipur directing the petitioner to appear before him and face

the departmental enquiry, which appears to be unjust and unreasonable; and further considering that this Court has granted similar indulgence in the case of Dalpat Singh Rathore, issue notice to the respondents, returnable within four weeks.

2. In the meantime and until further orders, the effect and operation of the notice dated 14.11.2025 (Annex. 6) shall remain in abeyance, and no proceedings shall be undertaken pursuant to the charge-sheet dated 14.12.2023 (Annex. 1).
