1. The petitioner has filed this bail application under Section 483 of BNSS in FIR No.337/2025 registered at Police Station Sadar, District Sri Ganganagar for offence under Sections 308(2), 308(3), 308(5), 111(2)(b) 351 (2) of BNS.
2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Public Prosecutor and perused the material available on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case. The allegation against the petitioner is that he has given shelter to the co-accused Vishnu Kumar who has been enlarged on bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 09.02.2026. He further submits that other co-accused namely Gurvinder, Rohit, Anil and Dilpreet also got the benefit of bail by a Coordinate Bench of this Court on 27.01.2026.

Though seven cases have been reported reported against the petitioner but the co-accused Rohit had also a criminal history of nine cases but he got the benefit of bail. He again submits that the petitioner is behind the bars and charge-sheet has been filed. The trial of the case may take considerable time and no further custodial interrogation is required, hence on the ground of parity, the bail application of the petitioner may be allowed.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor has vehemently opposed the bail application.

5. On consideration of the rival submissions and material available on record and in the light of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner especially on the ground of parity but without expressing any opinion on merits/demerits of the case, I am inclined to grant benefit of bail to the petitioner.

6. Consequently, the bail application under Section 483 B.N.S.S. is allowed and it is directed that the petitioner **Ankit Bhadu S/o Gauri Shankar**, be released on bail provided he furnishes a personal bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the sum of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial court with the stipulation that he shall appear before that Court on all subsequent dates of hearing till conclusion of the trial.
