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**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE KULDEEP MATHUR**

**Order**

**15/04/2026**

1. By way of filing the present civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for the following reliefs:-

*"It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed on behalf of petitioner that the writ petition may kindly be allowed and by an appropriate writ, order or direction this Hon'ble Court may be kindly pleased to:-*

*a) Direct that the pending Civil Misc. Case No. 7/2021 Before the Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Bali, District Pali, titled Manisha Kumari versus Naresh Kumar be adjudicated and decided in an expedited manner.*

*b) Grant such further relief(s) which in the facts and circumstances of this case may do complete justice to the petitioner; and.."*

2. After arguing the matter for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner would be satisfied if the learned Additional District Judge, Bali, District Pali is directed

to decide the application filed by the petitioner under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing No.7/2021, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months from today.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner to be just and reasonable, therefore, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Additional District Judge, Bali, District Pali to make all possible endeavors and decide the Application No.7/2021 pending since last six year, as expeditiously as possible.

5. It is expected from the learned Additional District Judge, Bali, District Pali to ensure expeditious disposal of the Application No.7/2021 and shall not grant unnecessary adjournments to the parties.

6. With the aforesaid directions, the instant writ petition as well as the stay petition stand disposed of.
