1. As these bail applications have been filed pertaining to the same FIR, they are being heard and decided by the instant common order.
2. These bail applications have been filed by the accused-applicants under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 in the matter arising out of FIR No.256/2025, registered at Police Station

Devnagar, District Jodhpur for the offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109(1), 189(2) of the BNS.

3. Learned counsel for the accused-applicants submits that the accused-applicants have falsely been implicated in this case. Learned counsel further submits that as per the Parchabayan, Nadir Khan has not been named in the FIR and no overtact has been assigned to the applicant Saddam. Learned counsel also submits that co-accused Bilal has been enlarged on bail by the trial court and Imran has been enlarged on bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court. Other co-accused persons, namely Virendra, Irfan, and Pervej have also been enlarged on bail by the trial court. Learned counsel also argues that the accused-applicants Saddam was arrested on 21.12.2025 and Nadir was arrested on 16.12.2025 and since then, both are behind the bars. Investigation is still pending. Learned counsel prays that trial will take long time to conclude, therefore, the accused-applicants be enlarged on bail.

4. Learned Additional Government Advocate vehemently opposes these bail applications and submits that as many as five other criminal cases have been registered against the accused-applicant Saddam. Therefore, in view of the criminal antecedents of the accused-applicant, he should not be enlarged on bail.

6. Heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the material available on record.

7. Considering the overall facts and circumstances of the case; looking to the period of custody of the accused-applicants; it is submitted that no specific allegation of causing any injury to the

injured Aman has been attributed to the accused Saddam and Nadir; further, the other co-accused persons namely Virendra, Irfan and Pervej have already been enlarged on bail and the trial will take long time to conclude, but without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it proper to allow these bail applications filed by the applicants.

8. Consequently, these bail applications filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 are allowed. It is ordered that accused-applicants namely **(1) Saddam Mehra S/o Shri Samandar Khan** and **(2) Nadir Khan S/o Shri Sikander Khan**, arrested in connection with FIR No.256/2025, registered at Police Station Devnagar, District Jodhpur, will be released on bail; provided each of them furnishes personal bond in the sum of Rs.**1,00,000/-** each and two solvent **attested** sureties of Rs.**50,000/-** each to the satisfaction of the trial Court. Applicants will be required to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
