1. The first Bail Application was dismissed as withdrawn by this Court vide order dated 01.08.2025 in S.B. Criminal Miscellaneous Bail Application No. 9379/2025.
2. The present second bail application has been filed by the accused-applicant under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 in connection with FIR No. 605/2020, registered at Police Station Kekri City, District Ajmer (Raj.), for the offence punishable under Section 8/15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.
3. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant submits that the accused-applicant has falsely been implicated in this matter. Learned counsel further submits that from the possession of co-accused Om Prakash, 220 Kg of poppy husk has been said to be recovered on 05.12.2020. Learned counsel also submits that no

contraband has been recovered from the accused-applicant-Pappuram. Learned counsel argues that the accused-applicant has been made accused in this matter only on the basis of disclosure statement of the co-accused-Om Prakash. Learned counsel for the accused-applicant further argues that except the statement of co-accused-Om Prakash, no other evidence has been found against the accused-applicant. Learned counsel contends that the accused-applicant was arrested on 02.07.2025 and since then, he is behind the bars. Learned counsel further contends that the charge-sheet has been filed and trial will take long time to conclude, therefore, the accused-applicant be enlarged on bail.

4. On the other hand, learned Deputy Government Advocate opposes the bail application and submits that nine other criminal cases including three cases of NDPS Act have been found to be registered against the accused-applicant, therefore, he should not be enlarged on bail.

5. Heard learned counsel for the parties and also perused the material available on record.

6. Having regard to the overall facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that no contraband has been recovered from the accused-applicant; that the accused-applicant has been made accused in this case only on the basis of statement given by co-accused; that the accused-applicant is behind the bars since 02.07.2025 and that the trial will take long time to conclude, but without expressing any opinion on the merits/demerits of the case, this Court deems it proper to allow this bail application filed by the accused-applicant.

7. Consequently, this second bail application filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S, 2023 is allowed. It is ordered that accused-applicant **Pappuram Siwar S/o Bhagwanaram**, arrested in F.I.R. No.605/2020, registered at Police Station Kekri City, District Ajmer (Raj.), shall be released on bail; provided he furnishes personal bond in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- and two solvent attested sureties of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

8. The accused-applicant shall be required to appear before that Court on all dates of hearing and as and when called upon to do so.
