1. The present first appeal has been filed by the appellants, assailing the judgment and decree dated 31.10.2025 passed in Civil Suit No.31/2021 (CIS No.106/2021) titled '*Smt. Malti & Ors. Vs. Jaipur Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited & Ors.*', by the learned Additional District Judge No.3, Jaipur Metropolitan-I, whereby the claim filed under Section 1-A of the Fatal Accident Act, 1855 has been partly allowed and a compensation of Rs.7,34,600/- along with interest @ 9% p.a.

2. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that from the cause title of the case, it is evident that there are as many as six plaintiffs, but while adjudicating the loss of consortium only, Rs.40,000/- has been awarded, which is contrary to the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *National Insurance Co. Ltd. Vs. Pranay Sethi*¹.

3. Heard.

4. In view of the above, issue notice to the respondents.

5. Learned counsel for the appellants submits that he is not seeking relief against respondent Nos.3 and 4.
6. At the request of counsel for appellants, service of notices upon respondent Nos.3 and 4, is dispensed with.
7. Let notice be issued to respondents Nos.1 and 2 only.
8. Notices be filed in two sets and upon filing the same, one set be sent by ordinary post and another by registered post, returnable within four weeks.
9. List this matter after four weeks.
10. Let the record of the learned court below be summoned.
