Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order dated 18.07.2023 passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.19782/2018 has not been complied by the respondents/ contemnors even after passing of more than two years.

Vide order dated 18.07.2023, the writ petition was allowed with the operative part as under:-

"26. Accordingly, this Court finds that the respondents are required to consider case of the petitioner for regularization in terms of the notification dated 27th February, 2009 and candidature of the petitioner has to be considered by treating him fully eligible, as he is not only having requisite educational qualification but also has experience of ten years as well on the cut off date, as has been fixed by the State Government in the notification dated 27th February, 2009, the petitioner has completed ten years of service on 10th April, 2006 i.e. cut off date, which has been fixed by the respondents.

27. Accordingly, the present writ petition is allowed. The respondents are directed to consider case of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of this order and the consequential benefits flowing from the regularization be conferred on the petitioner within the period given above."

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents/ contemnors No.1, 2, 5 & 6 submits that it is for the respondents/ contemnors Nos.1, 2 & 5 to comply with the direction of the Court made vide order dated 18.07.2023. Learned counsel further submits that unfortunately the respondents/ contemnors have not complied with the order of the Court so far and they may be allowed further two weeks' time to comply with the order of the Court.

The submissions of learned counsel appearing for the respondents/ contemnors clearly speak that the respondents/ contemnors have not complied with the order of this Court and thus, this Court prima facie finds that the respondents/ contemnors No.1, 2 & 5 are guilty for non-compliance of order of the Court.

Since the respondents/ contemnors No.1, 2 & 5 have been prima facie found to be guilty for disobeying the orders of this Court, now for the purpose of their prosecution and sentence, the respondents/ contemnors Nos.1, 2 & 5 are allowed one week's time to file their separate additional affidavit detailing the efforts made by them for making the compliance of the order of the Court so as to see whether the non-compliance by the respondents/ contemnors is deliberate and intentional.

On the next date of hearing, the respondents/ contemnors shall remain personally present before this Court.
