1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's husband passed away on 01.06.2023. It is further submitted that criminal proceedings were initiated against the petitioner, wherein conviction order dated 30.09.2003 came to be passed by the Additional District and Sessions Judge (FT), Bandikui. Subsequently, bail was granted to the petitioner vide order dated 29.04.2004, and the said conviction of the petitioner came to be stayed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 24.11.2005.

2. Learned counsel vehemently contends that the petitioner is a senior citizen and a widow, having no independent means of sustenance. In support of his submissions, learned counsel has placed reliance upon the judgment passed by this Court in **S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 3228/2023** titled **Richa Sharma v. State of Rajasthan & Ors.**

3. *Per contra*, Ms. Mahi Yadav, learned AAG, submits that the family pension has not been released in favor of the petitioner as per the relevant rules on account of the pending criminal case, which has not been actively pursued by the petitioner.
4. However, learned AAG is unable to refute the legal contentions put forth by the learned counsel for the petitioner at this stage and prays for some time to seek necessary instructions in the matter.
5. Time, as prayed for, is granted.
6. List the matter on 20.08.2026 in the supplementary cause list.
