Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that although, part of the benefits as directed vide order dated 14.09.2020 have been granted to the petitioner, yet so far as actual benefits of salary and arrears are concerned, the petitioner was entitled for such actual benefits w.e.f. 14.09.2020 on which date while deciding his writ petition, order of the dismissal was quashed with further direction of reinstatement. Learned counsel submits that merely on account of the fact that respondents have committed delay in reinstating the petitioner, such delay cannot be attributed to the petitioner, however, till this date, such benefits have not been given.

Learned Additional Advocate General prays for time to seek instructions in this regard.
