Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide impugned order dated 07.10.2025, the petitioner-firm has been debarred for a period of three years for participating in procurement process initiated by any procuring entity in exercise of powers given under Section 46 of the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 2012 (for short "RTPP Act"). He further submits that per the provisions of RTPP Act before issuing any order debarring a firm from participating in the procurement process, mandatorily they required to serve a show-cause to allow an opportunity of hearing but in the present case the impugned order has been passed without serving any notice to show-cause. He further submits that the action of the respondents in passing the impugned order is gross violation of principle of natural justice.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondents prays for and is granted two weeks time to file reply.



Taking into consideration the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner and so also the provisions of RTPP Act, the effect and operation of the impugned order dated 07.10.2025 shall remain stayed, till further orders.

The respondents would be at liberty to make an application for vacation of this interim order after filing of the reply.
