1. Being aggrieved by the inaction and unjustified delay on the
part of respondent Nos.1 and 2 regarding the rectification of the
petitioner's date of birth in his Class 10th mark-sheet, learned
counsel for the petitioner prays for liberty to file a representation
before the competent authority to seek the said rectification.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that to process the said rectification, the original school records of the petitioner will be mandatorily required, which shall be called for by respondent No.2.
3. Heard the submissions advanced by the learned counsel for the parties.
4. In light of the aforesaid submissions, the petitioner is directed to mark his presence before the competent officer/authority of respondent No.2 on 04.06.2026 at 11:00 A.M., either in person or through his advocate.
5. Moreover, respondent No.2 is directed to call for the relevant academic records of the petitioner from the concerned school and upon due verification of the same, the competent officer/authority shall pass a reasoned and speaking order, strictly in accordance with the law, on or before 30.06.2026.
6. The instant writ petition stands disposed of in the above terms. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed.
